*"We are blessed to be a blessing"*

The Lord said to Abram, "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you...and all the peoples on earth will be blessed through you." Gen. 12:1-3

Like Abraham, we who are blessed are called to be a blessing so that God may be glorified by all nations. We may know Jesus, but there are 2 BILLION PEOPLE in our world who don't!

This World Mission Sunday, consider these opportunities for your congregation and you, the individual, to be part of God's plan to draw all mankind back to Himself. *Look on the reverse of this leaflet for a few ideas.*

**First of all, most of all, Pray.**

The diocesan World Mission Committee has developed a Litany for Mission which is available on the diocesan Web site, [www.fwepiscopal.org](http://www.fwepiscopal.org). This can be used for daily prayers and for weekly services.

**Attend** a Parish Mission Leadership training event or program. We are educating our churches in global mission! The next scheduled event is the ServantPrep Seminar, March 11-13 at Camp Crucis.

**Participate** in the diocesan deacons' Lenten Starfish Program. Small daily donations made throughout Lent will bring food and emergency relief to Haiti.



**Become** a Centurion Congregation. Be a partner in ministry with the Church in Malawi for just \$100 each month.



**Participate** in the Mother's Day Ingathering, supporting the children of La Gran Familia in Cuauhtémoc, Mexico.

**Pray** for the Unreached People of Cambodia- that the Gospel will reach the 2 million people living in darkness there. Only .05% of the Khmer population is Christian.



**Volunteer** and go on a mission trip! Join the team from Camp Crucis as a servant this summer on an Indian Reservation or working to rebuild New Orleans.



**Attend** New Wineskins For Global Mission with other members of our diocese. This international mission conference will be held April 8-11 at Ridgecrest, N.C. Register at [www.newwineskins.org](http://www.newwineskins.org)

**Support** mission work. Make a monthly sacrificial donation to our long-term missionary in Cambodia, the church in Malawi (through our Malawi 500 program), or to the mission agency of your choice.
